## **The AILASA Prize for the Best Honours Dissertation**

The Association of Iberian and Latin American Studies of Australasia (AILASA) is seeking entries for the annual AILASA Prize for the Best Honours Dissertation in the field of Iberian and Latin American Studies produced in an Australian or New Zealand university in any given year. The prize of \$200 AUD will be awarded for an Honours dissertation produced in 2020. The judging panel will consist of the President of AILASA, or their representative, and up to three other judges. Only one award will be made per year.

In order to be eligible for consideration by the judging panel, the following eligibility criteria must be met:

- 1) The Honours dissertation must be on a topic related to Iberian or Latin American Studies. It may be written in English, Spanish or Portuguese, and must be produced in a New Zealand or Australian University, according to the relevant regulations of the university in question.
- 2) The dissertation must be recommended for consideration by a current, full member of AILASA. The AILASA member may be the supervisor of the dissertation.
- 3) The dissertation must be anonymised and accompanied by the examiners' reports and the grade that was received. The author's name must also be removed from the examiners' reports.
- 4) The dissertation must be submitted by the AILASA member recommending it to the panel by Friday 14 May 2021. Submission should be made to [ailasa@ailasa.org](mailto:ailasa@ailasa.org).
- 5) The dissertation may be revised for typographical errors before submission for consideration.

The winning author and their sponsor will be informed by 31 July 2021 via email by the President of AILASA.
