The AILASA Early Career Researcher Prize 2021

The AILASA Early Career Researcher Prize is awarded annually for the best journal article by an Early Career Researcher in the discipline of Iberian and Latin American Studies; including history, politics, literary and cultural studies, or any other field in the Humanities and Social and Sciences more broadly. Early Career Researcher is understood as someone within five years or equivalent from the award of their PhD (recognising some people may have experienced career interruptions). The prize will be awarded to a single- or multi-authored journal article published in 2020.

The prize of \$250 AUD will be awarded in 2021. The judging panel will consist of the President of AILASA, or his or her representative, and up to three other judges, including where possible one of the editors of the *Journal of Iberian and Latin American Research*. Past winners of the Prize will be encouraged to participate in the judging process. Only one award will be made per year. The judging panel reserves the right to not award a prize in any given year.

In order to be eligible for consideration by the judging panel, the following eligibility criteria must be met:

- 1) Only one journal article may be submitted per applicant per year.
- 2) The journal article must be on a topic related to Iberian or Latin American Studies in the Humanities and Political and Social Sciences. It may be written in English, Spanish or Portuguese.
- 3) Book chapters, publications in conference proceedings, review articles, etc. are ineligible for the prize.
- 4) The author must be a current member of AILASA to be eligible to apply.
- 5) In the case of multiple authors, the Early Career Researcher should be the lead author.
- 6) Submission should be made to the AILASA secretary via ailasa@ailasa.org by 31 July 2021 and include a copy of the publication in pdf, and a statement of eligibility.

The winning author will be informed by late October 2021 via email by the President of AILASA. Details of the winning article and author will be posted on the AILASA website. The judging panel may choose to announce a short list of up to 3 publications. If this occurs, the details of the articles and authors on the short list will also be posted on the AILASA website.
